NOTIFICATION FOR RECRUTIMENT OF TEACHERS-2008

1. In pursuance to the orders by the Government in G.O.Ms.No.159, Education Ser (VI) Department, Dated.05-12-08, G.O.Ms.No.161, Education Ser (VI) Department, Dated.06-12-2008 applications are invited from the candidates for selection to the posts School Assistants, Language Pandits, Secondary Grade Teachers and Physical Education Teachers in Government, Zilla Parishad, Mandal Parishad Schools and the schools under the control of Project officer, I.T.D.As and Municipalities in the state unit wise. Interested candidates are required to submit their applications in the prescribed form on any day from 15-12-2008 16-01-2009 to the District Educational to Officer of the District concerned, where he/she would like to seek selection. Candidates who desire to apply for more than one post based on their eligibility shall have to submit separate applications for each post.

Important Dates

- 1. Sale of application form from 15-12-2008 to 15-01-2009.
- 2. Receipt of application form from 15-12-2008 to 16-01-2009.
- 3. Written test 11th, 12th, & 13th of April, 2009.
- Application Forms will be available for sale at all Head Post Offices / Sub Post offices / e-Seva centers.
- 5. Filled in Application form has to be submitted to the concerned District Educational Officer.

2. <u>District-wise vacancy position is as indicated in Annexure - I(A),I(B),I(C) & I(D) & II & III (A) AND (B)</u>

Note: -

- I. The rule of reservation to local candidates is applicable.
- II. The rule of special representation in the matter of appointment of candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, Backward Classes, Physically Challenged, Exservice Men and women is applicable as per Rules and rule 22 of Andhra Pradesh State and Subordinate Service Rules as amended from time to time.
- III. The rules issued from time to time by the Department of Disabled Welfare on 1) Age relaxation 2) Minimum percentage of disability and 3) allocation of roster points for General and women candidates will be applicable.
- IV. Local Scheduled Tribe candidates will only be considered for selection and appointment against the vacancies in Scheduled Areas. (Agency area) as per Article 342 of the constitution of India i.e for the vacancies notified in annexure–I(B). They shall also be considered for selection to the posts notified in Plain area. Women, PH and Ex-service persons reservation shall be followed as per rules in force.

V. Notified vacancies are subject to variation on intimation being received from the appointing authority as per need in the School and based on the strength particulars, in such case the selection of the candidate will be cancelled at any time.

3. METHOD OF RECRUITMENT:

The Recruitment shall be through a selection process consisting of Written Test, and other criteria stipulated by the Government from time to time. The total marks shall be 100 (One Hundred). The details of allocation of marks for written test and weight-age to different aspects for different categories of posts shall be as decided by the Government from time to time.

4. **QUALIFICATIONS**

- (1) A candidate for selection to these posts shall possess academic and professional/ Training qualifications as mentioned in Rule 4, Rule 5 and Rule 6 as the case may be.
- (2) The certificate issued by an institution/University shall not be taken into consideration if the said institution/ University does not have Permission/Recognition of NCTE/UGC respectively as per Law.

School Assistants:

(a) School Assistant (Mathematics):-

Must possess a Bachelor's Degree with Mathematics as the main subject OR one of three equal optional subjects and a B.Ed degree with Mathematics as a methodology subject. The certificate or degree awarded to Single Subject candidates shall not be regarded as equivalent to Bachelors Degree.

(b) School Assistant (Physical Sciences) :-

A Bachelors Degree with Physics and Chemistry as optional subjects or one of the two as main and the other as subsidiary/ancillary Subject and a B.Ed. Degree with Physical Science / Physics / Chemistry as a methodology subject.

(c) School Assistant (Biological Science):-

A Bachelors Degree with Botany and Zoology as optional subjects or one of the two as main and the other as subsidiary subject and a B.Ed. Degree with Biological Science or Natural Sciences / Botany / Zoology as a methodology subject.

(d) School Assistant (Social Studies) :-

A Bachelors Degree with two of the following subjects as optional one of them as a main and the other one as a subsidiary subject -

i) History ii) Economics iii) Geography iv)Political Science v) Public Administration vi)Sociology vii) Commerce and a B.Ed. Degree with Social Studies/ Geography/ History/ Social Sciences as a methodology subject.

(e) School Assistant (English) :-

A Bachelors Degree with English as the main subject or one of the optional subjects or a Post Graduate Degree in English and a B.Ed Degree with English as methodology subject or Post Graduate certificate in Teaching of English or Post Graduate Diploma in Teaching of English.

(f) School Assistant (Telugu):-

Must possess a Bachelor's Degree with Telugu as the main subject or one of the three equal optional subjects or Bachelor's Degree in Oriental Language in Telugu (B.O.L) or its equivalent or a Post Graduate Degree in Telugu and B.Ed with Telugu as methodology Subject or Telugu Pandit Training or its equivalent.

(g) School Assistant (Hindi) :-

Academic qualifications :-

Must posses Bachelor's degree with Hindi as one of the full elective subject or Bachelor's Degree in Oriental Language in Hindi (B.O.L) or Praveena of Dakshina Bharat Hindi Prachar Sabha or Vidwan of Hindi Prachara Sabha, Hyderabad or any other equivalent recognized qualification in Hindi (BA degree Standard) or Post Graduate Degree in Hindi and along with any one of the following training qualifications.

(i) School Assistant (Kannada):-

Must possess a Bachelor's Degree with Kannada as the main subject or one of the three equal optional subjects or Bachelor's degree in Oriental Language with Kannada (B.O.L) or its equivalent or a Post Graduate Degree in Kannada and B.Ed with Kannada as methodology or Kannada Pandit Training or its equivalent.

(j) School Assistant (Tamil) :-

Must possess a Bachelor's Degree with Tamil as the main subject or one of the three equal optional subjects or Bachelor's Degree in Oriental Language with Tamil (B.O.L) or its equivalent or a Post Graduate Degree in Tamil and B.Ed with Tamil as methodology or Tamil Pandit Training or its equivalent.

(k) School Assistant (Oriya) :-

Must possess a Bachelor's Degree with Oriya as the main subject or one of the three equal optional subjects or Bachelor's Degree in Oriental Language with Oriya (B.O.L) or its equivalent or a Post Graduate Degree in Oriya and B.Ed with Oriya as methodology or Oriya Pandit Training or its equivalent.

(I) School Assistant (Marati) :-

Must possess a Bachelor's Degree with Marati as the main subject or one of the three equal optional subjects or Bachelor's Degree in Oriental Language with Marati (B.O.L) or its equivalent or a Post Graduate Degree in Marati and B.Ed with Marati as methodology or Marati Pandit Training or its equivalent.

(m) School Assistant (Bengali) :-

Must possess a Bachelor's Degree with Bengali as the main subject or one of the three equal optional subjects or Bachelor's Degree in Oriental Language with Bengali (B.O.L) or

its equivalent or a Post Graduate Degree in Bengali and B.Ed with Bengali as methodology or Bengali Pandit Training or its equivalent.

(n) School Assistant (Sanskrit) :-

Must possess a Bachelor's Degree with Sanskrit as the main subject or one of the three equal optional subjects or Bachelor's Degree in Oriental Language with Sanskrit (B.O.L) or its equivalent or a Post Graduate Degree in Sanskrit and B.Ed with Sanskrit as methodology or Sanskrit Pandit Training or its equivalent.

(o) School Assistant (Physical Education) :-

Must possess a Bachelor's Degree or its equivalent and a Bachelor's Degree in Physical Education or its equivalent or M.P.Ed.

Secondary Grade Teachers and equivalent cadres

(a) Secondary Grade Teacher:-

Must possess Intermediate Certificate issued by the Board of Intermediate Education, Andhra Pradesh and D.Ed. Certificate issued by the Director of Government Examinations, Andhra Pradesh.

Must possess a Bachelor's Degree with Urdu as the main subject or one of the three equal optional subjects or Bachelor's Degree in Oriental Language in Urdu (B.O.L) or its equivalent or a Post Graduate Degree in Urdu and B.Ed with Urdu as methodology or Urdu Pandit Training or its equivalent.

(e) Language Pandit (Kannada):-

Must possess a Bachelor's Degree with Kannada as the main subject or one of the three equal optional subjects or Bachelor's Degree in Oriental Language in Kannada (B.O.L) or its equivalent or a Post Graduate Degree in Kannada and B.Ed with Kannada as methodology or Kannada Pandit Training or its equivalent.

(f) Language Pandit (Oriya) :-

Must possess a Bachelor's Degree with Oriya as the main subject or one of the three equal optional subjects or Bachelor's Degree in Oriental Language in Oriya (B.O.L) or its equivalent or a Post Graduate Degree in Oriya and B.Ed with Oriya as methodology or Oriya Pandit Training or its equivalent.

(g) Language Pandit (Marati):-

Must possess a Bachelor's Degree with Marati as the main subject or one of the three equal optional subjects or Bachelor's Degree in Oriental Language with Marati (B.O.L) or its equivalent or a Post Graduate Degree in Marati and B.Ed with Marati as methodology or Marati Pandit Training or its equivalent.

(h) Language Pandit (Gujarathi) :-

Must possess a Bachelor's Degree with Gujarathi as the main subject or one of the three equal optional subjects or Bachelor's Degree in Oriental Language with Gujarathi (B.O.L) or its equivalent or a Post Graduate Degree in Gujarathi and B.Ed with Gujarathi as methodology or Gujarathi Pandit Training or its equivalent.

(i) Language Pandit (Tamil) :-

Must possess a Bachelor's Degree with Tamil as the main subject or one of the three equal optional subjects or Bachelor's Degree in Oriental Language with Tamil (B.O.L) or its equivalent or a Post Graduate Degree in Tamil and B.Ed with Tamil as methodology or Tamil Pandit Training or its equivalent.

(j) Language Pandit (Bengali) :-

Must possess a Bachelor's Degree with Bengali as the main subject or one of the three equal optional subjects or Bachelor's Degree in Oriental Language with Bengali (B.O.L) or its equivalent or a Post Graduate Degree in Bengali and B.Ed with Bengali as methodology or Bengali Pandit Training or its equivalent.

(k) Language Pandit (Sanskrit):-

Must possess a Bachelor's Degree with Sanskrit as the main subject or one of the three equal optional subjects or Bachelor's Degree in Oriental Language with Sanskrit (B.O.L) or its equivalent or a Post Graduate Degree in Sanskrit and B.Ed with Sanskrit as methodology or Sanskrit Pandit Training or its equivalent.

(I) Physical Education Teacher:-

Must possess Intermediate Certificate issued by the Board of Intermediate Education, Andhra Pradesh and an under graduate diploma in Physical Education (U.G.D.P.Ed.)

OF

Must possess a Bachelor's Degree and a B.P.Ed or M.P.Ed.

ADDITIONAL QUALIFICATIONS FOR THE POSTS NOTIFIED IN SCHOOLS FOR BLIND / DEAF AND DUMB:

Must possess a certificate / Diploma/Degree in Teaching for Blind / Deaf and Dumb in addition to the academic qualifications prescribed for the said posts.

- NOTE:- (1) The candidates who have passed SSC Examination in the concerned medium or with the concerned Language as First Language are eligible to apply to the posts in the concerned medium or the candidates who have passed the examination of Higher standards in the concerned first language / medium are also eligible to apply to the posts in that medium.
 - (2). Candidate with higher qualifications may also be eligible for selection, Provide he/she studied the required subjects for the posts he/she applied at Bachelor degree level.
- <u>Example1:</u> A candidate who intends to apply for the post of SA(Biological science) should have studied both Botany and Zoology subjects either at graduation level or one of the above two at graduation level and the other subject at Post graduation level.

- <u>Example2:</u> A candidate who intends to apply for the post of SA (Social Studies) should have studied at least one of the following mentioned subjects at graduation level and the other at Post graduation level. either at graduation level or one of the above two at graduation level and the other subject at Post graduation level.
 - i) History ii) Economics iii) Geography iv)Political Science v) Public Administration vi)Sociology vii) Commerce
 - (3) As per Govt., Memo. No.18103/Ser.VI-1/2005, Dated. 03-10-2005 and as per Government.Memo.No.14276/Ser.VI/2008-1, dated.01-12-2008 the Single subject Certificate holders of Dr. B.R.Ambedkar Open University, Hyderabad / any other University are also not eligible to apply for any category of teacher post.
 - (4) The certificates issued by the institution / University are not accepted if the said institution / University does not have Permission / Recognition of **NCTE / UGC** respectively.
 - (5) The candidates with M.A (Education) are not eligible fior any category of teacher posts in DSC-2008 as per Government.Memo.No.14276/Ser.VI/2008-1, dated.01-12-2008.
 - (6) The candidate with Special B.Ed. or D.Ed. qualification are eligible for teacher post in Special Schools only, as per Government.Memo.No.14276/Ser.VI/2008-1, dated.01-12-2008.

6. AGE:

Applicant must have completed the minimum age of 18 years and must not have completed the maximum age 39 years as on the $1^{\rm st}$ day of July 2008. However in case of BC/SC/ST candidate the maximum age limit is 44 years, and in respect of Physically Challenged candidates the maximum age limit is 49 years.

Upper age for Ex-service Men - A person, who worked in the Armed Forces of the Indian union, shall be allowed to deduct the length of the service rendered by him in the Armed Forces and also three years from his age for the purpose of the maximum age limit.

7. HOW TO APPLY:-

- I) Printed application forms may be obtained on payment of Rs.200 /- from 15-12-2008 to 10-01-2009 (both days inclusive) excluding the public holidays in all Head post Offices at the District Head Quarters and Head Post Offices /Sub Post Offices at the Revenue Divisional Head Quarters and e-Seva centres.
- II) Applicants should carefully read all the instructions before filling up the application form.
- III) Applicants should fill the application carefully, with his/her own handwriting.
- IV) The Applicant must enclose the following to his/her application.
 - a. Attested copies of Memorandum of Marks and Pass Certificates of the Educational Qualifications prescribed to the post.
 - b. Attested copy of Date of Birth Certificate (SSC or its equivalent certificate).
 - c. Attested copy of the caste ``certificate in the prescribed proforma issued by Mandal Revenue Officer in the case of S.Cs and S.Ts and B.Cs.

- d. Attested copy/copies of the study certificate(s) from the heads of Institutions for classes IV to X (S.S.C) or copies of the residence certificate as a proof of local candidate in case of the candidate who has not studied in any recognized school during the whole or any part of the Seven year period ending with his/her appearance for the first time for class-X (S.S.C) or equivalent examination.
- e. Attested copies of certificates of proof of visually Handicapped /Hearing Impaired /Orthopaedically challenged as the case may be.
- f. Apart from pasting a latest black and white passport size photograph on the application form, every candidate should submit 3(three) latest black and white passport size photographs.
- g. Three (3) self addressed envelopes of size 10"X4" each with stamps worth Rs 5/-.
- h. Service certificate obtained from the District Sainik welfare officer of the concerned District shall be submitted in case of Ex-servicemen if he claims the relaxation of age and reservation for selection under the Ex-servicemen quota. The Ex-servicemen who are drawing pension are only eligible to claim Ex-serviceman quota.
- V) Applications without all the relevant enclosures will not be accepted and will be rejected.
- NOT BE ACCEPTED.

8. RECEIPT OF APPLICATION:

Applications shall be submitted in person to the secretary of the District selection committee (District Educational Officer) of the concerned district, at the place/places indicated by the secretary of the District selection committee (District Educational Officer) on or before 16-01-2009 between 10.00am to 5.00 pm on all working days. The details of place/places of submission of application will be prominently displayed at the Collector's Office, Zilla Parishad and the Offices of District Educational Officer, Deputy Educational Officer and Mandal Parishad development Officer.

7. ORIGINAL CERTIFICATES FOR VERIFICATION:

All the original certificates shall be produced by the candidates for verification at the time of submission of applications. Applications of the candidates who do not produce the original certificates for verification will be rejected summarily. The candidate who produces a bogus degree or other certificate will be liable for prosecution besides other action as per rules. Mere acceptance of an application either inadvertently or otherwise shall not exonerate the applicant for submitting bogus certificate.

8. **ISSUE OF HALL TICKETS:**

Hall Tickets will be dispatched to the eligible candidates for written test by post. The hall tickets will be available in the website also. The candidates can download their e-hall ticket and can appear for the written test. The website address will be announced in all leading News Papers.

Note: <u>The secretary of the District selection committee (i.e District Educational Officer)</u> will not be responsible for any postal delay.

9. METHOD OF SELECTION:

Candidates shall be selected on the basis of marks secured in the written test conducted for 100 marks and following rule of reservation. The selection of candidate for the posts in Plain/Scheduled (agency) area under the control of Tribal department shall be taken up only after the selection of candidate for the posts in Plain/ Scheduled (agency) area under the control of District Educational Officer is completed. The candidate can, however express option by indicating his/her willingness in the application itself.

10. MEDIUM OF QUESTION PAPERS:

The Question papers will be in the medium concerned. The Question Paper in Telugu Medium will be supplied to the candidates appearing for the test to the post in Telugu Medium and likewise to other medium candidates.

11 WRITTEN TEST:

- i. The candidate should take the Test only in the district in which he/she submitted his/her application.
- ii. The candidate shall be required to answer multiple-choice questions by way of shading in the space indicated in the O.M.R sheet.
- iii. The marks for written test once awarded shall be final as there is no provision in the rules for revaluation of marks. However, prescribed Computer printout copy of scanned OMR answer sheet duly attested by the DEO, in respect of response (Answers) shaded by the candidates will be issued by the DEOs concerned on the dates and on payment of amount prescribed by the undersigned.
- iv. After due dates the above said Computer printout copy of scanned OMR answer sheet will not be issued at any cost.
- v. Appeals and objections on the Initial key will not be entertained at any cost after prescribed date. Final key once issued shall be final.
